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THE CHARITABLE TRUSTS ORDINANCE, 1994

LEMBAGA AMANAH KEBAJIKAN RAKYAT KATIBAS
DECLARATION, 2026

(Made under section 3(1))

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3(1) of the Charitable Trusts Ordinance, 1994 [*Cap. 7*], the Yang di-Pertua Negeri has made the following Declaration:

Citation and Commencement

1. This Declaration may be cited as the **Lembaga Amanah Kebajikan Rakyat Katibas Declaration, 2026**, and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 26th day of January, 2026.

Declaration of Charitable Trust

2. It is hereby declared that—

(a) a Charitable Trust shall be created and be known as the Lembaga Amanah Kebajikan Rakyat Katibas;

(b) the trust properties are as described in the First Schedule and shall be administered by a Board of Trustees appointed under section 4 of the

Charitable Trust Ordinance, 1994 [*Cap. 7*], for the benefits of beneficiaries specified in paragraph (c);

(c) the beneficiaries of the Charitable Trust shall be the non-muslims community of Katibas which shall include the community in Manap, Temelat, Song, Katibas, Tapang, Bangkit and Tekalit District whom may be decided by the Board of Trustees from time to time to be awarded the necessary benefits from the Charitable Trust; and

(d) the purposes of the Charitable Trust are as set out in the Second Schedule.

FIRST SCHEDULE

(Paragraph 2(b))

TRUST PROPERTIES

(1) Funds that have been or shall be donated, collected or pledged received from any sources for the Charitable Trust purposes stipulated in Second Schedule.

(2) Land, buildings and any other properties or assets, movable and immovable, including money, bonds and shares acquired or held or controlled for the Charitable Trust.

(3) Contributions, donations and gifts from any sources for the purposes of the Charitable Trust, including any legacies and properties bequeathed by will or other instruments for the Charitable Trust purposes set out in the Second Schedule.

SECOND SCHEDULE

(Paragraph 2(d))

TRUST PURPOSES

(1) The advancement of education, knowledge and capacity building of the beneficiaries specified in paragraph 2(c) of the Declaration;

(2) To administer and maintain any activities related to the non-Muslims public burial grounds in Song District;

(3) To raise, apply, receive and manage any grant, gift, donation, contribution or any sums for the Charitable Trust and the wellbeing of the beneficiaries specified in paragraph 2(c); and

(4) The relief of poverty and furtherance or support of any other charitable purposes which the Board of Trustees considers desirable or expedient from time to time for the benefits of the beneficiaries specified in paragraph 2(c).
