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THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF SARAWAK

THE MINISTERS OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT (ASSIGNMENT OF PORTFOLIOS)
ORDER, 2019

(Made under Article 9 (1))

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 9(1) of the Constitution of the State of Sarawak [*G.N.S. 163/63*], the Yang di-Pertua Negeri, in accordance with the advice of the Chief Minister, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the **Ministers of the State Government (Assignment of Portfolios) Order, 2019**.

(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 22nd day of August, 2019.

Ministerial functions

2.—(1) It is ordered that the persons named in the first column of the Schedule shall have the styles and titles of office as specified in the second column corresponding to their respective names in the Schedule.

(2)(a) The person whose name is mentioned first in the first column of the Schedule in relation to any Ministry, Department or Agency and subject specified in the third and fourth columns corresponding to his name shall be the person charged with the responsibility for that Ministry, Department or Agency and subject; and

(b) be assisted by the persons whose names appear underneath that first mentioned person's name in the first column.

Revocation

3. The Ministers of the State Government (Assignment of Portfolios) Order, 2019 [*Swk. L.N. 430/2019*] dated 19th day of September, 2019, is revoked.

Saving and transitional

4.—(1) Where there is a reference to a Minister with a particular style or title in any written law in relation to any functions under that law and that style or title is changed by this Order, that reference shall be deemed to be a reference to the Minister with the new style or title.

(2) Where there is a reference to a Minister with a particular style or title in any written law in relation to any functions under that law and the functions have been transferred by this Order to another Minister, that reference shall be deemed to be a reference to the Minister to whom the functions have been transferred.

SARAWAK CULTURAL HERITAGE ORDINANCE, 1993

**SARAWAK CULTURAL HERITAGE
(MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF THE SARAWAK MUSEUM COMPLEX)
RULES, 2019**

(Made under section 35(1)(J))

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 35(1)(j) of the Sarawak Cultural Heritage Ordinance, 1993 [*Cap. 6*], the Minister with the approval of the Yang di-Pertua Negeri, has made the following Rules:

Citation

1. These Rules may be cited as the **Sarawak Cultural Heritage (Management and Control of the Sarawak Museum Complex) Rules, 2019**.

Interpretation

2. In these Rules –

“Collections” includes antiquity, treasure trove, historical object, human remains, fabric, structure, ethnographic material, work of art, manuscript, document, book, coin, stamp, currency note, medal, badge, insignia, crest, flag, armour, weaponry, vehicle, ship, vessel, plant and animal or part of, which has a significant and special architectural, aesthetic, historical, tangible and intangible cultural heritage such as songs and dances, oral tradition, scientific, economic, or any other subject of interest or value to the State and its people that are kept by Sarawak Museum or within its care;

“Sarawak Museum” means the Sarawak Museum described under rule 3;

“Ordinance” means the Sarawak Cultural Heritage Ordinance, 1993 [*Cap. 6*];

“State” means the State of Sarawak; and

“study or research” means subject to Sarawak Research and Development Council Ordinance, 2017 [*Cap. 74*] any study or research carried out relating to the Collections, other antiquities, ancient and historical monuments or objects, and archaeological sites.

The Sarawak Museum

3.—(1) The Sarawak Museum shall comprise of the buildings, areas or sites and the respective compound stated in the First Schedule.

(2) The Minister may, with the approval of Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri, amend the Schedule.

Authorized repositories

4. The Sarawak Museum described in the Schedule shall be the authorized repositories for the Collections.

Functions of the Director

5. The Director shall have control over the management and administration of the Sarawak Museum and any matters related thereto, including the safe custody of its properties and the collection there in.

Appointment of agent or independent contractor

6. Subject to any directions that may be issued by the Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri, the Director may, with the approval of the Minister, appoint any person to-

- (a) to build, manage or maintain the Sarawak Museum; and
- (b) to undertake the provision of services, within the Sarawak Museum.

Powers and duties of the Director

7. The Director shall have the powers to—

- (a) protect, preserve and add to the Collections;
- (b) secure the Collections exhibited at the Sarawak Museum;
- (c) secure the Collections for inspection by any person permitted in writing by him for the purpose of study or research;
- (d) generally promote the public's enjoyment and understanding of Sarawak heritage and its development;
- (e) appoint any person to execute and manage any of his functions which he deems necessary, subject to the approval by the Minister;
- (f) with the approval of Majlis Mesyuarat Kerajaan Negeri, impose any fee for admission into any part or parts of the Sarawak Museum and for the conduct of any activities or event carry out within the Sarawak Museum;
- (g) determine the operating schedule of Sarawak Museum;

- (h) promote the State, national and international role of the Sarawak Museum;
- (i) promote the preservation, conservation, restoration, enrichment and care of the Collections;
- (j) promote a wide understanding of and access to the Collections;
- (k) research relating to Collections;
- (l) promote the use, care and development of the Sarawak Museum buildings and sites;
- (m) promote the reputation of the Sarawak Museum;
- (n) promote transparency and efficiency in the administration and prudent financial management to enable the Sarawak Museum to fulfill its aim; and
- (o) do all things reasonably necessary for the performance of his duties under the Ordinance and these Rules.

Prohibitions

8. No person shall—

- (a) within the compound of the Sarawak Museum—
 - (i) consume food and drink except area designated as cafeteria or restaurant;
 - (ii) consume alcohol or other intoxicating agents; and
 - (iii) smoke cigarettes and e-cigarettes.
- (b) lead or carry animal onto the compound of the Sarawak Museum;
- (c) carry weapons, items and substances which may pose a threat to life, health and safety;
- (d) enter the buildings within the Sarawak Museum under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicating agents;
- (e) use drones in the Sarawak Museum compound;

(f) use of a metal detector or Ground Penetrating Radar (GPR) detection device or equipment unless with a valid licence to excavate issued by the Director;

(g) sale of food and drink or conducting any commercial activities unless with a written permission by the Director; and

(h) contravene any other prohibitions issued or directed by the Director from time to time.

Direction of the Director

9. The Director may give directions of a general character (not inconsistent with the Ordinance and these Rules) through Circulars, Notices or Memorandum as to the exercise of his functions under these Rules.

Penalty

10. Any person who contravenes any provision of these Rules shall be guilty of an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to a fine of not exceeding two thousand ringgit.

THE LAND (MARKET VALUE OF PROPERTY FOR FOREIGN ACQUISITION)
(AMENDMENT) DIRECTION, 2019

(Made under section 13E(2)(c))

1. This Direction may be cited as **the Land (Market Value of Property for Foreign Acquisition) (Amendment), Direction, 2019**, and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 23rd day of May, 2019.

2. Paragraph 3 of the Land (Market Value of Property for Foreign Acquisition) Direction, 1998 [*Swk. L.N. 114/98*], is amended by—
